Patim

is a professional response to the phenomenon of addiction and social exclusion. A model is not intended to be unique. Its current name comes from the acronym PATIM, synthesizing the five fields in which this organization began working in 1985. Some of them have evolved to adapt to new consumption patterns, behavior and treatment.

Today is a nonprofit entity of the Third Sector specialized in involvement and integration of addictions and other behaviors. In its last stage, commitment to the quality services, promotes labor insertion and violence treatment, with the primary action framework in the province of Castellón. It has been declared as a "public interest".

The year 2011 makes that many entities are considering the possibility of continuing to exist, us - nongovernmental organizations that we have contributed to develop a state where wellbeing should take precedence.

New models are coming to the third sector, our representatives in the regional and state level will be converted, as well as our bodies. Time will be time to secure new partnerships.

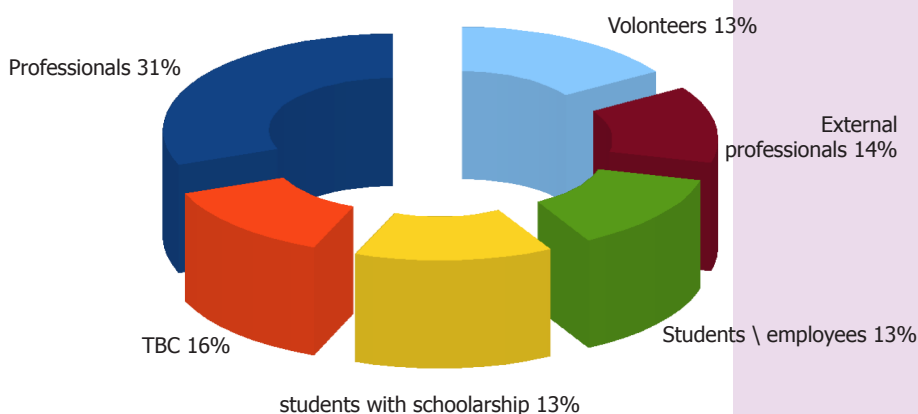

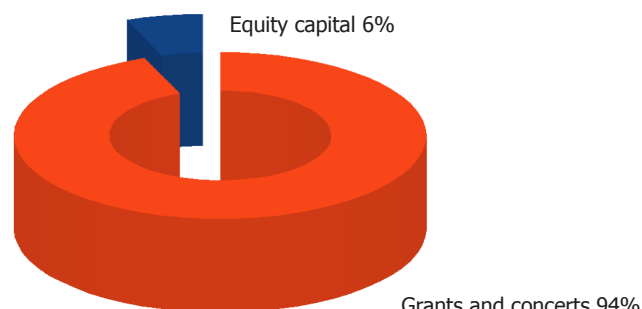

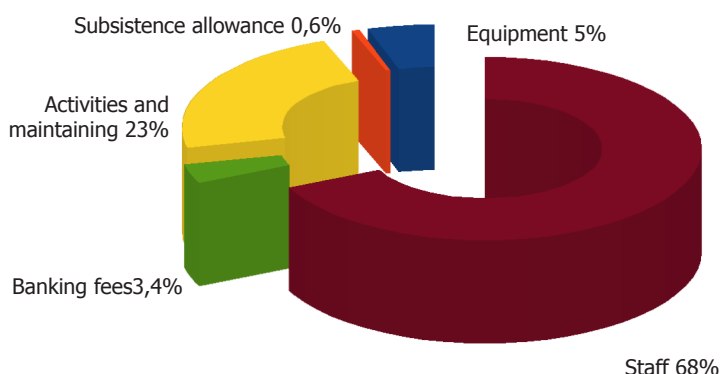

It is the main field of action for the next years along with the employment. Since its founding, PATIM works continuously to develop actions in this area that are intended to reduce or prevent the use and / or drug abuse and, therefore, the problems associated with it, and promote healthy lifestyles and training programs which are suiting us to the new requirements.

The communication is one of its main tools. This area is structured from the program called Open Classroom in three major areas. It has been performed in school centers and has been given the basic steps to create new opportunities for preventing of drug addiction and other behaviors.

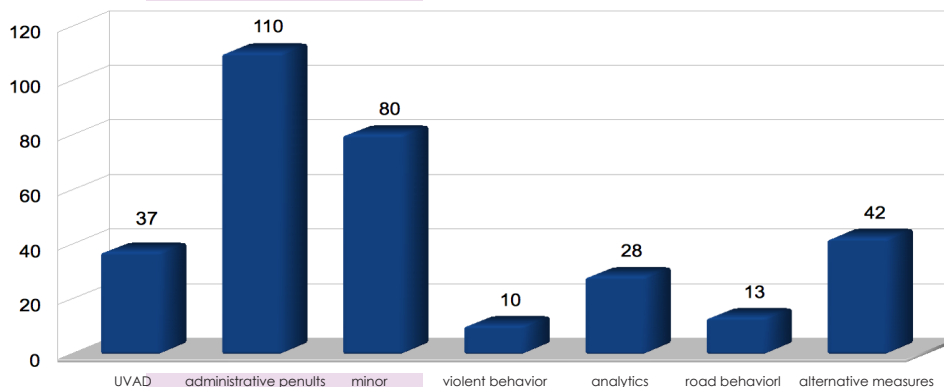
320 cases treated

Serves as effective technical support to the estates judicial on those subjects related to psychoactive substance use and other behaviors, as well as dysfunction in the behavior of people, advising and evaluating those cases where the existence of a problem results conflicts of

legal nature. It also develops specific programs within penitentiary centers but it has stopped lending to police intervention in Castellón and Vila-real. The main activities of the Legal Advisory Service and Intervention (SAJI) are focused on:

- Assessment unit and support in drug addiction (UVAD). Advisory and legal expertise
- Control and monitoring of alternative security measures
- Administrative penalties
- Control of community service workers
- Analytical control of prisoners in third grade
- Intervention in behavior:
 - Violence (in penitentiary center and open environment)
 - Education for masculinities
 - Road traffic safety
- Intervention specialized in children under care or custody and their families

Profiles

SAJI

Male, between 18 and 41 years old, of Spanish nationality, single, unemployed with primary education complete. Consumer of cocaine, cannabis and alcohol, the main route of administration is smoking, has begun to consume between 15 and 18 years old.

Violent behavior

(In prison environment)

Male, 27 years old, single or separated, with children, graduated school, using alcohol and cocaine, with a target of work within the prison. Regarding to nationality, there is equality in the number of cases among Spanish and foreigners.

CARE 478 cases treated

The various resources in this area aim to achieve the detoxification of the people with addiction problems toxic and nontoxic. Its mission is to provide, on an outpatient basis and / or commitment-residential, detoxification treatment, rehabilitation and reintegration, using pharmacotherapy, psychological, occupational and social, promoting active participation of patients to promote their social normalization.

The ultimate goal is to facilitate the social integration of these people and others considered at risk of social exclusion through professional and specialized care.

LABOR INTEGRATION

489 cases attended

Service guidance, training and information for finding a job. It manages the flat of insertion. Its mission is to develop individual skills for a job and to keep it. A center of integration has

been opened in Castellón, which has shifted the youth information point, and still maintaining actions in Vinaròs. In 2011 it achieved the employment of 41 persons across 22 companies.
